2026 MassDOT Helping Hand Mini Grant Program

This program awards eligible recipients with grants amounting up to \$1,000 (10% local match required) for funding transportation related capital costs. Though open to all applicants, rural and small urban providers are prioritized. The application deadline is 5PM on **Friday, July 24th**.



MassDOT's Shared Streets and Spaces

Every municipality and regional transit authority in massachusetts is eligible to apply. This grant focuses on quick build projects to improve plazas, sidewalks, curbs, streets, bus stops, parking areas, and other public spaces in support of public health, safe mobility, and strengthened commerce. The deadline to apply is **August 7th**.



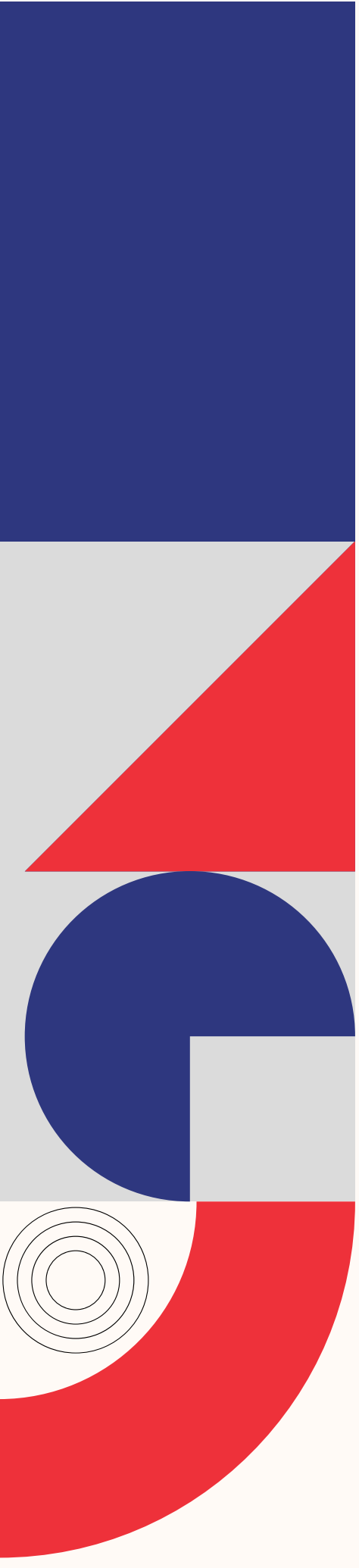
Complete Streets Grant Program for Municipalities

This grant focuses on addressing gaps in local transportation networks by supporting streets that provide safe and accessible options for all travel modes. The deadline to apply is **August 7th**.
